- ▶ A commercial diver is the most common type of professional diver that works for pay.
- ▶ A number of different types of commercial divers, most common is the offshore diver working in the oil and gas industry.
- Commercial divers are extremely skilled professionals.
- ▶ They often work in challenging (dangerous) circumstances
- Require the proper training and certification necessary to meet regulations of the local authority.

HAZMAT

Divers

- divers who work under dangerous conditions.
- Work under special circumstances due to the dangerous material they dive in, such as pollution and chemicals, as well as the very dangerous sewer diving.
- **HAZMAT** divers must take precautionary measures to deal with the threat of contamination.

- Nuclear divers work under conditions like **HAZMAT** divers.
- Different precautionary measures are taken to prevent the exposure of radiation.
- They may use a cold water suit to prevent heat stress from contaminated areas.

- Study scientific data found underwater.
- Scientists as much as they are divers. trained in both professions.
- The work is done both offshore and inland.

- Work in underwater filming and photography.
- Trained camera operators who mostly cover projects meant for television documentari es and movies.
- Also known as . naval divers
- Do military **operations** underwater.
- Involves offensive and defensive military tactics.
- Repair on military vessels and underwater equipment.
- May move into different areas of commercial divina after they leave the military.
