Call for Applications



The Halifax and Nova Scotia Chapters of the Canadian Welding Bureau Association (CWBA) are seeking applications from candidates interested in taking a 20 hour Introduction to Aluminum Pipe Welding course. General course information can be found in the attached "Schedule A". This course will be partially sponsored and up to four (4) candidates may be selected.

Program Timeline

- Application open: March 25, 2024
- Application deadline: March 29, 2024
- Course Start: Friday April 19, 2024 (12 pm) for five (5) consecutive Fridays
- Course End: Friday May 17, 2024 (4 pm)

Eligibility Criteria

1. Candidate must be a Canadian citizen and a permanent Nova Scotia resident.
2. Successfully completed a previous accredited welding program.
 - A copy of the diploma to be included with the application.
3. Must be willing to pay a maximum of \$500.00 CDN toward the cost of the course.
4. Candidate must submit an Essay following the requirements.

Essay Requirements

- Minimum 250 words, maximum 500 words.
- Please include in your essay submission:
 - A brief description of yourself.
 - Describe how you were introduced to the welding profession and what current contributions to the profession.
 - Share a significant achievement you experienced in your career.
 - What are your current career goals?
 - Describe how you would benefit from attending this welding course.
