TEAMS

2-4 people, at least one should have welding ability. We will be limiting the competition to one team per school or company.



FEES

Company Teams: \$200 per team, includes dinner.

Student Teams: Free

Spectators: \$15 per person, includes dinner.



PPE

Competitors: All competitors must wear appropriate PPE which includes long pants, CSA-approved steel-toed shoes or boots, safety glasses, welding helmets, FR welding jackets and welding gloves.

Spectators: All spectators who wish to go into the welding area must wear long pants, safety glasses and steel toes.



TOOLS
