Phil McGregor Award Student Bursary - 2018

This Phil McGregor Award is sponsored by the Canadian Welding Association and awarded to promote welding excellence, creativity in metal fabrication and industrial safety. It is also awarded to help raise awareness of the Canadian Welding Association Winnipeg chapter and participation in the chapter events.

The prizes will be awarded to high school and/or post-secondary students who present their most interesting weld or metal fabrication project done in the last year. This project could have been completed at school, or at home. Students shall present their project with a written description and a picture (or pictures)

PRIZES: The top 3 entries will receive prizes of \$1500, \$1,000 and \$500 respectively. Half of the award will be presented at the announcement, and the other half may be mailed to the student following the announcement (provided by the CWA Foundation).

Submission Details:

- 1) Please submit a description (200-500 words) of your project that includes:
 - a. The welding steps and process used
 - b. What are you the most proud of in your project
 - c. What did you do to make sure you followed all safety precautions while completing your project
- 2) Please include at least one photo of your project (max 3 photos).
- 3) Students must be or become CWA members, which can be done at no charge on the website www.cwa-acs.org
- 4) Students must present a registration form and get it approved by their welding instructor whom also has to be a registered CWA member.

Scoring

Originality	30 points
Execution of project	30 points
Safety Measures	30 points
Attendance at CWA event	10 points
