## **OUR NEXT MEETING DAY DECEMBER 7th, 2023**

<u>Presentation Topic: Girth Weld Strength Matching</u> Presented By: Nick Khotenko and Cory McIntosh, ATCO

The purpose of this presentation is to provide a basic overview of the pipeline girth weld matching problem, discuss specifics on how ATCO is currently managing the problem in practice, and how it plans to manage the problem in the long-term including potential future fuels such as hydrogen.

Nick Khotenko is a Mechanical Engineer and has worked in ATCO's natural gas division since 2013. Nick has worked in several positions within ATCO including Project Management, Construction, and Quality. He has experience in project lifecycles, pipeline selection/biding, constructability, technical review, welding, and quality.
