

This Phil McGregor Award is sponsored by the Canadian Welding Bureau Association – Winnipeg Chapter and awarded to promote welding excellence, creativity in metal fabrication and industrial safety.

The prizes will be awarded to high school and/or post-secondary students who present their most interesting weld or metal fabrication project done in the last year. This project could have been completed at school, or at home. Students shall present their project with a written description and a picture(s).

**PRIZES:** The top 3 entries will receive prizes of \$1500, \$1,000 and \$500 respectively.

**Submission Details:**

1. Please submit a description (200-500 words) of your project that includes:
  - a. The welding steps and process used
  - b. What you are the most proud of in your project
  - c. What you did to make sure you followed all safety precautions while completing your project
2. Please include at least one photo of your project (max 3 photos).
3. Students must be CWBA members, which can be done at no charge on the website <https://www.cwbgroup.org/association>
4. Students must present a registration form which is approved by their welding instructor, who is also a registered CWBA member.

Originality	30 points
Execution of project	30 points
Safety Measures	30 points
Attendance at CWA event	10 points
